The piano/keyboard consists of white and black notes White Notes = Natural or Regular notes Black Notes = Sharps and Flats depending on how you address the note

How to play piano chords with absolutely NO knowledge of ...

Count up in semitones to 5, then 8, and you now have a major chord whose name will be the same as the 1 note you picked This same pattern (1, 5, 8) is used for all 12 major chords Minor chords, sometimes thought of as sad sounding chords, are constructed in a similar way The difference is that instead of playing a 1,5,8 pattern, we now use a

These 5 horizontal lines are a staff Time Signature Bar line Notes on the staff The diagram below is an example of music notation using the treble clef staff that 6-string guitarists use: G Treble Clef/G Clef The diagram on the right is a Treble Clef or G Clef - it is called this as it surrounds the G line
