Long-eared Owl *Asio otus* Habitat Preference: The Long-eared Owl is considered an edge species because it alternates its time between dense woodland patches and adjacent grassland and prairie marshes It typically nests and roosts in thick stands of conifer trees Ideally the trees are rank and the limbs reach the ground
